Wrote and illustrated the book (1913) "The Story of Edinburgh Castle." He illustrated numerous books including "The Fringes of Fife." He was a balloonist-observist and war artist who painted "The Battle for Courcellette" in 1918. He witnessed this battle as a soldier in WWI. The capture of the ruined town of Courcellette, France on September 15, 1916 was a significant Canadian victory. The painting was acquired for the national collection of art in Ottawa, Canada. He was almost the only witness to the controversial exploit of Canada's air ace Billy Bishop on June 2, 1917.

He was born in Edinburgh and studied at the Royal Scottish Academy Schools, and in Paris. He is best known for his pictures of the Great War, but he also did a lot of architectural paintings and etchings. Somewhat confusingly, his paintings bear the signature "Louis Weirter," while his etchings are signed "Louis Whirter." He illustrated a number of travel books. He lived in London and at Étaples in France.

He was an original member of the Scottish Society of Artists and exhibited at the Royal Academy, the Paris Salon and other exhibitions in many parts of the world. Of his war pictures, The Battle of Courcellette was bought for the national collection at Ottawa. The painting, War in the Air is in the British War Museum.

Battle of Courcellette Painted by Louis Weirter in 1918

Like the observer in the tree in the foreground, painter Lieutenant Louis Weirter witnessed this Somme battle as a soldier. The capture of the ruined town of Courcellette, France on 15 September 1916 was a significant Canadian victory. It was one of the few bright moments in a campaign in which British forces suffered more than 500,000 casualties.

As witness to famous exploit of Billy Bishop, Canadian air ace: In relatively recent years, the testimony of the British balloonist

Louis Alexander Weirter, who passed away in 1932, has been discounted on the grounds that he would have been too far away to see the action at Estournel. However, the weather was actually quite good that morning in that area of the Front, particularly the visibility from above looking down. With the action occurring at Esnes and westward, Weirter would have been closer than previously thought, at approximately 10 miles range. **10. **Notes for THOMAS ADAMS:**

Famous city planner who founded the American City Planning Institute. He worked with Frederic Law Olmsted Junior, and with Franklin D. Roosevelt and Hebert Hoover. He and his team published the Regional Plan for New York in 1929. Adams then moved to Harvard University to carry out research and write planning textbooks. He argued for the green spaces between towns with clear arteries of landscaped parkways and railways between them, and in towns for linked parks to be the heart of a foot-friendly circulation system. By the early 1930s, Tommy Adams had such prominent standing as an expert in town planning and subdivision development in North America that many of his writings were adopted as best practice by government and professionals. He advised President Hoover's Conference on Home Building and Home Ownership, 1932, the largest federal conference held till that time. And President Roosevelt, coming in with the New Deal, was an old friend of the quiet businesslike Scot from his days as New York State Governor. It was President Roosevelt who wrote the foreword to Adams' Outline of Town and City Planning in 1935.

Back in Britain, Adams advised briefly on the planning of London, Edinburgh and Dundee. He presided over the Institute of Landscape Architects and helped to guide King George VI's Coronation Planting Committee, writing a little book on Playparks with suggestions for their Design, Equipment and Planting. After his death in 1940 his two sons become major figures in British and American town planning. The elder, James Whirter Renwick Adams led the planning service for the English county council of Kent; his brother Frederick J. Adams taught planning at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. In the same year-1948- the Town Planning Institute elected James as its president and the American Institute of Planners elected Frederick as its president.

Uncle Vinny gave me a copy of a "Certificate of Election to party Position" Suffolk County - to certify that in the Primary Election held in and for the count of Suffolk, on the 6th day of September 1949, George Weierter was duly elected by the Democratic party to the party position of Alternate Delegate to Town Convention and for the 19th Election District of the Township of Babylon. This was signed 9/9/1949 by R. A (or H) Hairston (I think), and Wm. H. Clayton. According to Kenneth Weckerle, he was also a member of the Lindenhurst Board of Education for a time.

In 1924 George Weierter constructed the clubhouse for the newly formed World War Veterans' Club on the corner of Broadway and West John Street for (\$5,160). (Source: SouthBayNews.com, 2002, 0828) He was also the contractor for the building of the Lindenhurst High School on Wellwood Avenue, that is currently the Middle School.

George had somewhat of a hot temper. According to stories told by his son Edward to his daughter, Ann, fights between his parents involved throwing pots and pans, and one time, a bowl of food out the window. Yet, Ann remembers him as being a kind and loving grandfather. As a young girl during WWII, George would hold her in his lap and "read the map" to her from the Journal American newspaper each day. His poor eye sight required the aid of a magnifying glass to do so.

Then north in Atlantic, stop in Haiti to drop off very ill merchant seaman. Then north to Galveston, Texas. Discharged to New Orleans Navy Yard Sick Bay for physical exam. Then sent home on 30 day leave of absence.

After leave, back to Brooklyn - assigned to new ship, S.S. William James. Four trips across North Atlantic to Europe. One to Liverpool, one to Manchester, one to Bristol, and the last one we were sent to Ireland. Anchored out in the sea for weeks until they knew where in France they would need the supplies we were carrying on our ship. They called for us to come over to the military headquarters in France for orders. We then headed south to a small town south of Brest. No dock so we anchored out in the bay and unloaded our barges. About 3 to 4 weeks of leave on shore. Spent some time in Brest "German Substation" finding souvenirs and junk to bring home. One of the trips we had to stop in Nova Scotia for repairs. Our ship was breaking in half - they put a belly band around it. Back to the States - discharged - leave of absence a few days. Assigned to war bond selling station in NY in Rockefeller Center a couple of months. Reassigned to Bayonne Navy Yard in NJ - "N.S.O.T.C." Navy Ship Operational Training Center. Acting first class Boatswain Mate. While I was there, Bob was born, I got home for a couple of days. When war was over, I was discharged from Lido Beach, NY in November of 1945.

I received six medals - mostly area ribbons - one from Russia, for delivering war goods to them. The goods we brought to Iran were trucked up to Russia."

He was wearing two of the badges now in my possession. My cousin and I found the exact spot where the picture was taken on the front lawn of the home on West John Street looking toward Wellwood Avenue. The picture and badges are now married in one box frame for all time. I then discovered that a ledger existed for the Union Hook and Ladder Co. No. 1 which went all the way back to May 15, 1882.
